The Scholarship Award

- ~ The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000 per year.
- ~ The scholarship will be paid directly to the college or university.
- ~ The scholarship will be awarded to the winning recipient for a maximum of 4 years providing the AACFB Young Farmers Committee is financially able to renew the scholarship. If the recipient earns a Bachelor's degree in less than 4 years, the scholarship will be terminated at that time.

Eligibility requirements:

- ~ Parent or student must be or become an Anne Arundel County Farm Bureau member. Membership (\$55) can be acquired through MFB at [www.mdfarmbureau.com](http://www.mdfarmbureau.com).
- ~ Must be a graduating high school senior or college student.
- ~ Must plan to attend full-time to any community or 4-year college.
- ~ Must be registered in an agriculture or agricultural related curriculum.

Scholarship recipient:

- ~ A check will be sent to the college before each fall semester. It is the student's responsibility to ask their college if the money can be split between both semesters.
- ~ At the end of each spring semester, the scholarship recipient is responsible for submitting an unofficial copy of their transcript, which includes the cumulative GPA, to the secretary of the AA Co Farm Bureau Young Farmers. The following year's payment will not be sent until this is received.
- ~ Must remain in the specified curriculum with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better.

Scholarship candidates must submit:

- ~ Scholarship application (attached)
- ~ High school or college transcript
- ~ Two letters of recommendation - at least one from a teacher with knowledge of the student's academic background
- ~ A letter giving the reasons why you have selected your program of study and your future plans.
- ~ A printout of the course requirements for the degree you have chosen or include the web link on the application.

**Application deadline is April 15<sup>th</sup>.**
